### Background:

Escondido's General Plan was adopted in 1990 as a statement of long-range policy that guides the use of private and public lands within the city's boundaries. The Plan is a declaration of the community's values, aspirations, and projected growth. It establishes goals and provides a comprehensive program for development. State law requires that a city's general plan be kept up-to-date in order to accurately reflect the community's current values and priorities.

The updated General Plan will chart the city's growth out to 2030 and beyond, during which time the region can anticipate to add up to one million additional residents, according to SANDAG, San Diego County's regional government agency. Obtaining public input early in the process is critical because it helps define the scope of the update, guides the decision-making process, and forms the basis on which various technical studies will be prepared.

1. Soliciting your vision for Escondido's future
2. Options for accommodating anticipated population growth
3. Evaluating current Quality of Life Standards
4. Updates and ability for feedback on policies related to:

- Economic Development
- Smart Growth and Sustainability
- Water Quality and Availability
- Land Use
- Housing Needs
- Environmental Quality
- Public Safety and Services
- Public Transit
- Traffic Circulation
