Traffic Enforcement Detail-Results

On November 19, 2009, the Escondido Police Department and several outside agencies conducted a Traffic Enforcement Detail from 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The emphasis of this traffic detail was to address traffic violations throughout the city and to provide a highly visible operation to deter unsafe driving. Currently the department is participating in the Click It or Ticket Safety Campaign and seatbelt violations were one of the primary enforcement efforts during today's detail.

Some of the locations where enforcement occurred resulted from citizen complaints about speed and other traffic safety issues.

The following statistics were generated during the operation:

- **303** traffic citations were issued
- **33** vehicles were impounded
- **35** of the traffic citations issued were for seatbelt violations

This operation was conducted in conjunction with C.I.T.E. (County-wide Inter-Agency Traffic Enforcement). 31 traffic officers participated in this operation of which 8 were from the City of Escondido. Also participating were officers from the San Diego Police Department, La Mesa Police Department, Carlsbad Police Department, Oceanside Police Department, National City Police Department, Chula Vista Police Department, and Coronado Police Department.
